This Agreement Made the 10th day of February 1846 between William Williams of the one part Margery Williams of the other part Witnesseth, that whereas at the request of said William Williams the said Margery who is his daughter and law came to his house to reside with him in character of housekeeper & manager of his family affairs on July 25th 1837 for the annual compensation of one hundred dollars to be paid to her for her services at the end of each year, and whereas the said sum of money hath not been paid to her - and the said Margery yet continued to reside with him & act as housekeeper & manager as aforesaid - and whereas it is right & proper that said Margery should be compensated for her troubles & labour which is incessant and fatiguing - Now therefore be it known that the said William Williams do hereby agree to pay to her the said Margery the full amount due to her for arrears as here as aforesaid to this date being the sum of six hundred fifty six dollars ninety six cents (\$656.96) - and I also agree with her to continue to pay to her at the same rate of one hundred dollars yearly during the time she may continue to remain with me as housekeeper as aforesaid, and it is distinctly understood that this allowance is over and above & in addition to her sustenance & boarding for which the said William Williams make no charge - I do witness whereof the said William Williams have hereto set my hand the date above written (Given February 10th 1846
