I Frederick Williams of Edgefield district, and Clouds Creek being sick but of perfect mind and memory, thanks be given unto God, Do make and ordain this my last will & testament And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me with in this life, I give demise and dispose of the same in the following Manner and form, and first I desire that all my just debts shall be paid Secondly I give and bequeath to Nancy my dearly beloved wife one certain sorrel horse with saddle and bridle one Negro Woman Member during her widow hood and in case of her Marrying then the said Negro woman with her increase to be sold and the moneys to be Equely divided amongst the Legatee whose Names is mentioned here mentioned after, one feather Bed and furniture one half dozen Earthen plates, also a Childs part in the Rest of my Estate, Thirdly I give and bequeath unto my beloved sons Frederick Williams William Williams Jesse Williams Richard Williams Samuel Williams and Margaret Pope to have an Equel part of my Estate after deducting what they have already Received as for Welfter axels a horse bridle and saddle & bed and furniture and four cows and calves to each of the above named Children which can be proved they Received also to be deducted out of their Shares, fourthly I give and bequeath to my son Daniel Williams one bright Bay filley with saddle & bridle as also seventy dollars to be paid him by my Executors out of my Estate before the divide is made, ~~As also~~ an Equel Share with the other of my Children, fifthly I give and bequeath to two sons John Williams & Joseph Williams each twelve dollars 50 cents for to School them as also each of them a horse with bridle and saddle each to be valued to one hundred dollars to be paid them by my Executors out of my Estate and to have an Equel Share with the other of my named Children after deducting the prices of the horses bridles and saddles, and sixthly I give and bequeath unto my son Phairah Williams and my daughter Sarah Ann Williams each twenty one dollars 50 cents untill they arrive to the age of twelve years also fifty dollars each for to schooling them to be paid out of my Estate by my Executors and to have an Equel Share with my other named Children and in case of either of the deaths

of the above named Children before Marriage or amongst the Living or their heirs the bequeathed and also my will is that all the Remainder of my Estate Lands Negroes and other property of whatsoever shall be sold to the highest bidder on giving bonds upon the Credit with a proved security at the discretion of my Executors, I do here by constitute make, and ordain my wife Nancy and my two sons Jesse Williams and Richard Williams Executors and Executors of this my last will and Testament, And I do hereby ratify, disaffirm, revoke, and disannul all and every other former testaments, wills Legacies bequests, and Executors by me in any wise Maked, written, and bequeathed, Satisfying and conforming this and no other to be my last will and Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of sept<sup>r</sup> in the year of our Lord 1801, and of the 17<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence of the United States of America.
