No. 106. KNOW YE, That Lewis Wells Junior
of Jackson County, Missouri,
having deposited in the General Land-Office, a Certificate of the Register of
the Land Office at *Kassasville* whereby it appears that full Payment
has been made for the *East half of the South East quarter*
of Section Fourteen, in Township Six South,
of Range Two West, containing Eighty acres

of the Lands directed to be sold at *Kassasville* by the Acts of Congress,
relative to the disposal of the Public Lands in ILLINOIS, There is granted,
by the United States, in pursuance of the Acts of Congress in that case provided,
unto the said *Lewis Wells Junior* and to his heirs
the *half quarter* Section of Land above described: To have and to hold
the said *half quarter* Section of Land, with the Appurtenances, unto the said
Lewis Wells Junior his Heirs and Assigns forever.
