The following deed of conveyance from Isaac Reed to Lewis Wells was produced in open Court & acknowledged by the sd. Isaac Reed and caused to be recorded pursuant thereto on the day of December A.D. 1790.

South Carolina This Indenture made this thirty first day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the fifty seventh year of American Independence between Isaac Reed of the County of Greenville of the one part & Lewis Wells of the other party planter of the County & State aforesd. Witnesseth that the sd. Isaac Reed for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds lawful Sterling Money to him in hand paid as in & before the writing & delivery of these presents by the sd. Lewis Wells the Receipt whereof the sd. Isaac Reed with hereby acknowledges & thereof & of & from every part & parcel thereof with acquit & discharge the sd. Lewis Wells his heirs & assigns & for divers other Goods & consideration hereunto moving have granted bargained sold & aliened conveyed & confirmed & by these presents do bargain sell convey & confirm unto the sd. Lewis Wells his heirs & assigns for ever all that tract of Land lying & being in a County and District by the name of County & on the Head of Rocky Creek a Branch of the River containing two hundred acres & fixed by grant unto the sd. Isaac Reed & signed by his Attorney Thomas Finckley on the second day of July 1787 as by the first & plat annexed thereto will fully appear beginning a Water Mark at the top of running a line & rock stations on a Spanish Oak thence to a station on a Black Oak & across on a Black Oak marked thus 47 thence to a station on a Spanish Oak & thence to a station on a field Oak & thence to a station on a Spanish Oak & across on a Black Oak marked thus 48

Doth these two estates or whate ever shall come to the execution of this or either of the said two to the beginning together with all & singular the said houses & houses ways paths passages & premises & appurtenances & appurtenances whatsoever to the said parcel or parcel of lands as aforesaid or belonging or any way appertaining to the said parcel & premises & appurtenances & appurtenances whatsoever profits thereof & every part & parcel thereof that the whole right title & interest claim & demand whatsoever both in Law & equity of the said Isaac Reed of his to the Appurtenances & of his to every part & parcel thereof to have to hold the said premises or parcel of land & all & singular the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Lewis Wells his heirs & assigns the only proper use & behoof of him the said Lewis Wells his heirs & assigns for ever and lastly the said Isaac Reed for himself his heirs the said parcel or parcel of land & all & singular the premises above granted with their appurtenances unto the said Lewis Wells & his heirs & assigns against all persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & for ever defend In witness whereof the said Isaac Reed hath hereunto set his hand & Seal this day & year first above written.
