Ellen was born in Jim Henry township in Miller County, MO to James Anderson Stone and Priscilla Jane West in 5 Aug 1856. Her father was mortally wounded in the battle of Helena, Arkansas on July 4, 1863. He probably died in the Confederate Hospital at Polks Plantation, west of Helena. It was not long after his death that they moved to Moniteau County. Ellen married William E. Williams on 9 Jan 1876. Her grandfather John W. West married them. John West was a Primitive Baptist preacher. They farmed in Moniteau County (probably the farm of Fidelio's at Hwy C and CR 120). William contracted tuberculosis and they sold the land in the late 1890's and moved to Jefferson City. After William's death in 1900, her daughter, Olive Zeluma died in 1902. We don't know how she died but it may have been tuberculosis. The family moved to Hannibal shortly after. In 1910 she married Leonard Bragg. He died in 27 Mar 1923. She married Frederick Bangert on 29 August 1929. Frederick died on 20 January 1934. Ellen died on 1 Mar 1934. She is buried in Hope cemetery next to her son, George Williams.
