Generation 1

 Susannah¹ Mary was born in 1742. She married Edward Corder on 06 Sep 1777. He was born about 1730 in VA. He died about 1810 in VA.

Notes for Edward Corder:

On Sept 6,1777 Edward Corder took an oath of allegiance sworn to state in Captain McCorkles Company of Montgomery County, VA by Stephen Trigg. In April 1781 he was listed in a compnay of Montgomery County Militia. Edward was on the Montgomery County tax records from 1787 through 1801. He was on the Wythe County personal property tax lists in 1802 with one tithable over 16 (himself). From 1803 to 1806 there were two Edward Corders taxed, then just one through 1811. He died in 1810 and had nine children.

On 24 July 1758 Frederick County, VA: Edward Corder voted for Col. George Washington. From: VA Mag of History & Biography Vol. 6, p. 153. Also from "Colonial Soldiers of the South 1732-1774" by Murtie June Clark., p. 513: Edw'd Corder in Virginia Militia under Colonel (George) Washington. and on p. 515 (same date) was Edward /Corder under Colonel F. B. Martin.

On 18 May 1761 Poll taken at the election of Burgesses, Frederick County, VA. Under Colonel Geo. Washington was Edward Corder. From "Colonial Soldiers of the South 1732-1774" by Murtie June Clark., p. 555. On page 549 Edw'd Corder was under Col. Adam Stephen (same date).

1768 Edward Corder, Jr. leased land from Edmund Lindsey, Jr. in Frederick County, VA - witnessed by Jacob Lindsey. Frederick County VA Deed Book 12, page 545 purchased on Nov 1, 1768 and recorded the next day.

From Vol. 1 "Early Adventurers on Western Waters" by Mary B. Kegley, Vol 1, p. 114: On page 164 of Commissioners Certificate Book: Edward Corder 400 acres on the north side of Peak Creek, settled 1774.

1774 Edward Corder, 7 days driving cattle. From "Soldiers of Fincastle County, Virginia" by Mary B. Kegley. Page 58.

On 6 Sep 1777 Edward Corder took oath of allegiance sworn to state in Capt. McCorkles Company of Montgomery Co. by Stephen Trigg. In April 1781 he was listed in a company of Montgomery County Militia.

On 3 Aug 1782 For 60 pounds a grant was issued to Edward Corder for land on Peak Creek in Montgomery County, VA. WItneses were William Hance, Pearson Barney, & H. Edmunson. This was recorded 1 May 1802.

On 11 Feb 1783 Washington Distr. of Montgomery Co., VA Deed Book B, p. 123: An entry on 345 acres in Montgomery Co. on the west side of Peech Creek, a branch of New River. Corner to George McCowan survey.

On 8 Nov 1787 Montgomery Co., VA Platt Book F, p. 26: Edward Corder, assignee of David Croutch: 100 acres in Montgomery County on the west side of Peek Creek, a branch of New River.

On March 1802 Edward & Susanna Corder to Andrew Moorhead - Montgomery County Deed Book C, p. 500.

On 2 Sep 1802 Susanna Corder signed dower away to Andrew Moorhead - Montgomery County Deed Book C, p. 552.

On 14 Oct 1802 Edward Corder (Sr) bought 176 acres of land on Maidenspring Fork of Clinch River from Andrew Thompson and Rebecca his wife.

Edward Corder was on the Montgomery County, VA tax lists from 1787 through 1801. He was on the Wythe County, VA personal property tax lists in 1802 with one tithable over 16 (himself). From 1803 to 1806 there are two Edward Corders taxed, then just one through 1811.

Generation 1 (con't)

Edward Corder Sr. was on a Grand Jury on 27 Apr 1808. It is not known whether it was Edward Sr or Jr who remained in Tazewell County through 1811.

Edward Corder and Susannah Mary had the following children:

- i. ELEANOR² CORDER was born about 1764 in VA. She married JOHN STOBOUGH on 12 Feb 1787 in Montgomery CO, VA.
- ii. Benjamin Corder was born about 1769 in VA. He died on 28 Aug 1851 in St. Johns, Auglaize Co, Ohio. He married Rebecca Runyon on 07 Apr 1798 in Montgomery County,VA, daughter of Isaac Runyon and Geertje Charity Haganan. She was born in 1775 in VA. She died about 1844 in Benton County,MO.

Notes for Benjamin Corder: Interred in St. John Cemetery, Union township, Ohio

Benjamin Corder first appears on the personal property tax lists of Montgomery County, VA on 21 Mar 1798 next to Edward Corder. He is taxed there through 1802, then from 1803 through at least 1820 he is taxed in Tazewell County, VA.

In 1825 he was taxed on 125 acres on Cains Creek in Lawrence County, KY. From 1826 through 1829 he is taxed on 75 acres on Big Blain Creen in Lawrence County, KY.

1820 Census Tazewell Co., VA: Benj. Corder: 141201-21210-03

I830 Census of Lawrence Co., KY Benjamin Corder: 00010001-01010001 (both adults 50-60 & thus born 1770-1780))

Moved to Benton County, MO probably in the mid 1830's. He is there with James in the 1840 census. He moved back to Ohio in the late 1840's, probably after his wife died as she is not shown in the census in Ohio.

The 1850 census of Auglaize County, OH shows Benjamin Corder, age 80 living with his son, John Corder, and family. This was in Cloy Twp, family #451.

The names of the children were taken from "A History of the Pioneer Families of Missouri" by Wm. S. Bryan & Robert Rose, St. Louis, MO. Publ. 1876.

iii. ELIJAH CORDER was born in 1770 in Montgomery CO, VA. He died in 1807 in Tazewell Co, VA. He married SUSANNAH. She was born about 1765. She died in 1808.

Notes for Elijah Corder:

Note: Elijah Corder died of rattlesnake bite and is thought to have been the first settler to be buried in Burkes Garden. He died after taxes were levied in 1807 and before 22 Sep 1807 when it was ordered that his personal estate be appraised

- iv. WILLIAM CORDER was born about 1772 in VA. He died in , , Ohio, USA. He married ROSANNA BRUMFIELD on 20 Aug 1794 in Montgomery CO, VA, daughter of Humphrey Brumfield and Sarah Sartain. She was born in 1775 in Montgomery County, VA.
- v. Susannah Corder was born about 1773 in VA. She died on 19 Mar 1820. She married Edward Morgan on 03 Mar 1791 in Montgomery CO, VA. He was born in 1751 in Leeds, England. He died in 1844 in Montgomery CO, VA.
- vi. Mary Corder was born in 1776 in Montgomery CO, VA. She died in 1815 in Tazewell Co, VA. She married Thomas Cassady on 19 Jan 1797 in Montgomery CO, VA. He was born on 11 Aug 1765 in Prince William, VA. He died after 1850.
